Dear Family and Friends,

As we enter into the blessed seasons of Advent and Christmas, it is an incredibly appropriate time to slow down and make an attempt to observe more times of silence. I realize that I am suggesting something counter cultural, but perhaps such self-possession against the rush, anxiety, and stress of the holiday season will open our eyes even more to the tender and mystical realities surrounding us in the liturgical celebrations.

Every Sunday I give the Novitiate Sisters lesson—diving into some aspect of our charism, life, and service to the Sacred Priesthood. In these weeks before Christmas I hope to impart to them and to you a great love for silence. Why? It is not intended to create a moody vacuum or an arena for self-focused and petty thoughts or imagination. The fantastic reality is that there is a Person inside of us—dwelling in the home of our soul. He walks the corridors of our hearts! Do we keep Him company with blessed conversation and acts of faith, hope, and love?

The Christ Child was born for us and came to pitch His tent among men, first by assuming our human nature. Then he pitches his dwelling tent in each one of us through the gift of Baptism and the life of grace. Just as our Lady tenderly wrapped Him in swaddling clothes to keep Him warm, so let us keep Him warm against the coldness of hearts; let us recognize His Presence in us and gratefully keep Him company. He gave us His blessed Presence; let us be present to Him.

Know that we hold each of you close to our hearts in prayers and sacrifice. We wish you a very blessed Christmas!

Magnificat: The Eucharistic Congress


